This two story educational facility encompasses state-of-the-art athletic facilities for a wide variety of sports. This athletic development facility includes a wrestling gymnasium, new varsity locker rooms, training rooms, fitness center, weight room, and coaches' offices.

Additionally, one of the first major projects that Fleming designed for CCHS was the Tom Nix Stadium: home to Christian Brothers High School football since 1996, and those driving by the campus on Friday nights can see the 4,000 seat stadium alive with the excitement of CBHS's football tradition. Fleming has also designed the baseball stadium, an indoor practice facility, new locker room spaces, training rooms, and a gymnasium, among others.
