The University of Tennessee at Martin challenged Fleming Architects, along with joint venture partner Lyle Cook Martin, to create a unique recreation facility that promotes not only healthy lifestyles, but also encourages social interaction. The two story recreation center includes a gymnasium with four collegiate size basketball courts, weight rooms, cardio fitness area, racquetball courts, dance and aerobics studios, classrooms, offices and gathering spaces for students. The facility was designed to fit seamlessly with the campus's existing infrastructure, pedestrian ways, and vehicular traffic.

Since its completion in 2010, the Student Recreation Center is the most used building on the University of Tennessee at Martin's campus.
